## Getting Started:

Who taught you about marriage early in life? or...  
Whose lives showed you what marriage is supposed to look like (either in good ways or bad ways)?

## Diving in:

### Read 1 Corinthians 6:14-16

- What do you think it means to be “yoked” with another person?
- Why might it be important *not* to be yoked with unbelievers in our marriages and closest friendships?
- What benefits have you tangibly seen in marriages where the husband and wife are equally yoked?

**Stirring things up:** Do you think it's better to be married than single?

- Consider 1 Corinthians 7:1 and Matthew 19:10-11

### Read Philippians 4:12

- What might Paul mean when he says he's found “secret of being content”?
- To what extent does your contentment with life depend on your spouse's attitudes and actions? (How true does this ring: “If Momma ain't happy, nobody's happy!”?)
- How might your marriage change if you experienced contentment/completeness in Christ more consistently?
