#### **Read THE Word:**

- Sunday, January 31<sup>st</sup>: Luke 1-3

#### **Study THE Word:**

**Open:** You are at the parade celebrating the Colts Super Bowl victory. Would you rather watch the parade up in the grandstands, or join the parade down on the street? Why?

**Read:** Have someone in your group who feels comfortable read the Zacchaeus story in Luke 19:1-9. (If you feel really comfortable, you can sing the "Zacchaeus Song" together as a group!)

#### **Study:**

1. Like Zacchaeus, you are watching Jesus and his followers parade into town. Would you rather watch the parade up in the grandstands, or join the parade down on the street? Why?
2. Look at Luke 19:6-8, and list as many acts of obedience that indicate Zacchaeus' life has truly been changed. Which act of obedience would be the most difficult for you?
3. Have someone in the group read the key verse of the Book of Luke written out below. Why might it be a surprise to some to learn that Jesus is the real seeker and not Zacchaeus?
4. Sunday's message began with the phrase, "He's only human"? Why is Jesus the only person who has ever lived of whom it can not be said, "He's only human"?
5. Is it more difficult for you to personally understand the deity of Jesus or the humanity of Jesus? Why is it hard to really believe that Jesus really is like us?
6. Hebrews 4:15 says Jesus "has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet was without sin." How does the fact that Jesus didn't throw the "God Card" help when you too are tempted?

**Pray:** In the Garden of Gethsemane, Jesus specifically asked his friends to pray for him. As you share prayer requests in your group, be sure to specifically ask your friends to pray for you.

#### **Memorize THE Word:**

**The Humanity of Jesus:** "The Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost."

Luke 19:10 (NIV)

#### **Meditate on THE Word:**

This week, mediate on Luke 19:10 and the fact that Jesus came to seek and to save you.
