#### **Study THE Word:**

**Open:** Have a few people share some really GOOD NEWS they've heard or experienced this week.

**Read:** Have someone in your group who feels comfortable read Romans 1:16-17 out loud.

**Study:**

1. What is "The Gospel"? What effect does it have upon your life?
2. What is the Kingdom of God? What does it mean to live in God's Kingdom on an everyday, practical level?
3. What does it mean to repent? Describe a time in your life when you needed to repent of something. What effect did that repentance have upon your life?
4. Have someone read through the entire eighth chapter of Romans out loud for the group. Talk about some of the incredible promises you heard from God in this chapter. How should these truths affect the way you live?
5. Why do you think Paul used the term "living sacrifice" in chapter 12? What does it mean for you personally to offer your body as a "living sacrifice"?
6. Discuss this statement: The power to choose what you think about is one of the most incredible powers in the entire universe. Do you agree or disagree?

#### **Memorize THE Word:**

Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God-- this is your spiritual act of worship. Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is-- his good, pleasing and perfect will.

As a group, discuss practical ways that you could continually and actively practice "renewing" your minds this week. Is there a way you could "check in" with each other during the week to see how it's going?
